As Toft has not had a village pub for some time, a bar was installed in the refurbished People’s Hall in 1999 to provide a welcoming venue for village residents and their friends to get together. The Social Club was set up, which allows members to make use of this bar. We open four times a week (Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday evenings). Real ale, lager, wine, spirits and soft drinks are available at very competitive prices. We organise regular events which include a fortnightly quiz, bingo, food nights, an annual beer festival and wine-tasting evenings.

All residents of Toft Parish over the age of 18 can become members for a one-off fee of £1. Young people between 14 and 18 may become ‘Junior Associates’ at no charge, so long as their parent(s) or guardian(s) are full members of the Club.
